DHVT strives to strengthen and empower breast cancer survivors and supporters through the challenging sport of dragon boating, instilling in its members the values of teamwork, fitness and community giving.

Why Dragonboating? Born of a time-honored Chinese tradition, dragon boating has roots over 2,000 years old. The tradition has transformed into a fun paddle sport that appeals to all ages. Twenty paddlers sit two abreast on 10 bench seats in a 41-foot-long boat. A steersperson stands in the back guiding the boat. A drummer sits on the bow and beats out the cadence of the strokes. The trick to making the boats surge through the water is for everyone to connect with their teammates and paddle exactly in sync. It is a great unifier! The appeal of dragon boating is truly universal. Why? Because it is challenging! It is teamwork at its finest! It is exciting to watch! It is fun!

The LCDBF is DHVT's major annual fundraising effort to ensure that our non-profit organization may continue to successfully carry on with its mission to offer wellness and support programs to those who have been impacted by cancer. The LCDBF is a community-wide event that invites people to team up with DHVT to raise funds for a local cancer-related organization known as our "Pledge Partner." Our pledge partner is an organization that also supports cancer patients, their families, and supporters. This year's pledge partner is McClure Miller Respite House.

The McClure Miller Respite House, Vermont's only Medicare-certified inpatient hospice residence, is a home away from home for people with terminal illnesses. Their outstanding care and facilities allow families to spend quality time with their loved ones without worry of financial impact. Approximately \$1,000,000 of care is provided that is not reimbursed by Medicare/Medicaid each year and must be made up through donations.

The LCDBF is the perfect trifecta: Community fundraising, raising awareness regarding breast cancer and dragon boat paddling. It is a wonderful community building experience, and it offers a shared thrill of accomplishment. Knowing each has contributed to supporting a purposeful, meaningful, and often, a close-to-home cause.
